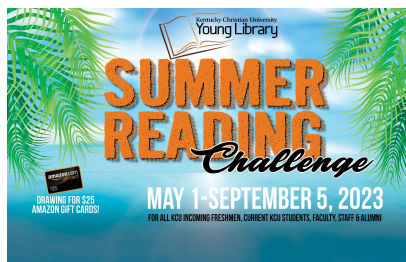

SUMMER READING PROGRAM



KCU's Summer Reading Program is off to a good start! Forty-four books have been read by 12 KCU faculty, staff, students and alumni. Remember that even if you are an incoming Freshman, you can participate! We would love for you to join our KCU family!

To participate, select any book—fiction, non-fiction, graphic novel, eBook, or audio book. Then read the entire book. To get credit for reading a book, you must notify Naulayne Enders at nenders@kcu.edu with the title of the book, the author of the book, and the year you graduated from KCU if you are an alumnus.

For each book that you complete, your name will be placed in a drawing for a \$25 Amazon gift certificate. A total of 5 gift certificates will be awarded. You must be a KCU student for Fall 2023 which includes graduate and online students, a KCU faculty/adjunct member, a KCU alum or a KCU staff member to participate.

You can find books to read at your local library, on free eBook sites or eBooks in our KCU library catalog. Any titles that are posted will also be pinned to our library [Pinterest page](#) for you to browse in case you want to read what someone else has read.

Library Technology Helpful Hints

Goodreads is a free site that allows you to search for books, annotations, quotes, and reviews. You can find reading lists in their Listopia section to find other books in a particular subject area, etc that are similar to what you like to read. You can sign up for a free account and then keep track of what books you have read, how many books you have read in a year, or participate in a reading challenge. You can join book discussion groups and sometimes you can join author talks/interviews. This is a great tool to use to help you keep track of what you are reading.
