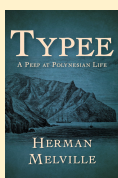

New Activity

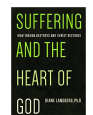

Library Technology Helpful Hints



This month we discuss ways to utilize your desktop screen to enhance your computer productivity using **folders** and **shortcuts**!

Firstly, creating **folders** on your desktop is a great organizing tool. Right-click while on the desktop screen. A menu will appear. Look for the "New" option, then hover over it. The next option that appears is a manilla file folder icon titled "folder." Select this, then name your folder (example: Research Paper). Now, you can drag any appropriate files from your desktop to this folder, and you can save new documents directly to it!

Secondly, add website **shortcuts** to your desktop to save time! While on a website, click and drag the lock icon in the URL bar at the top of the window into an open space on your desktop (make sure your browser isn't in full screen mode to do this). Now, simply double-click this icon to enter the site!
