## WHAT ARE YOU READING?

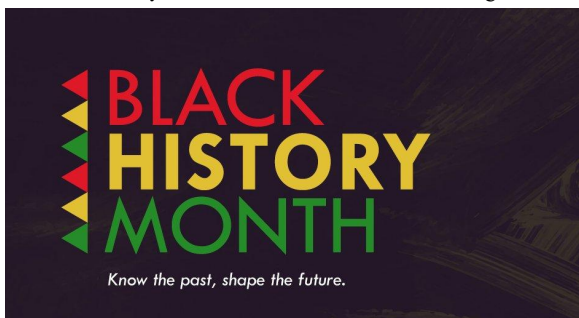

Stop by the library during February to see our Maya Angelou display in The front of the library. Read some of the books that are located in our library.

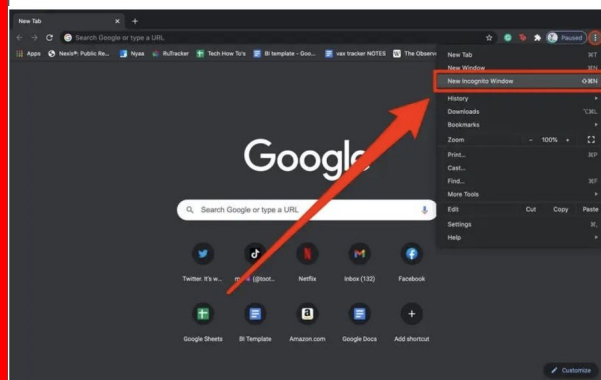

## INCOGNITO or NEW INPRIVATE or PRIVATE WINDOWS



Do you try to sign in to your myapps.microsoft.com account on a library computer and find that it keeps reverting to someone else's email? Are you worried that you will leave your passwords or private information behind? We recommend logging in to an Incognito Window (Google), a New InPrivate Window (Microsoft) or a Private Window (Firefox). When you open a search screen, just look for 'dots' or a stack of 'lines' at the top right corner of your screen. Using these windows will allow you to search and not retain browsing history, cookies, or passwords. When you are done, close the window & your information is wiped. Need help? Stop by the library!
