- Lived 1866-1943 in England
- Was an accomplished scientist - particularly botany, horticulture, and mycology in which she made lasting contributions.

- Wrote over 60 books, but is most famous for her 23 children's books.
- 1906: Peter Rabbit was the first fictional character to be made into a stuffed toy!

Library Technology Helpful Hints: Digital Literacy

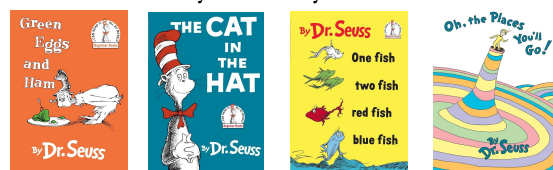

March is a fun-filled time for us. Check out our featured displays throughout the library!

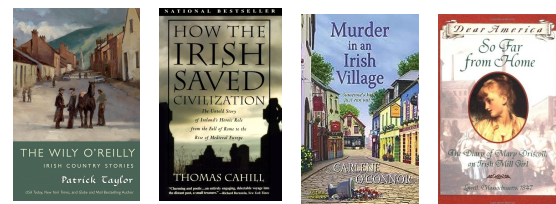
Read Across America Week:
