## *Library Tech Tip: Hole Punching*

Did you know that the new copier in the library will also punch holes as it is printing from our computers? To set it up, click on your document, click on 'file', click on 'print', click on 'Print using dialog system', click on 'more settings'. Look for the "Finishing" tab at the top of the printing box & click on it. Look for the "Hole Punch" feature. When you toggle the off button, it will provide a drop down for you to select 2 or 3 holes. Click on 'ok' and then click on 'print'. Need help? Ask a friendly librarian!
