KCU's Summer Reading Program is off to a good start! Eighty-four books have been read by 18 KCU faculty, staff, students and alumni. That is a 52% increase in titles & a 66% increase in participants compared to last summer at this time! Remember that even if you are an incoming Freshman, you can participate! We would love for you to join our KCU family!

To participate, select any book—fiction, non-fiction, graphic novel, eBook, or audio book. Then read the entire book. To get credit for reading a book, you must notify Naulayne Enders at nenders@kcu.edu with the title of the book, the author of the book, and the year you graduated from KCU if you are an alumnus.

For each book that you complete, your name will be placed in a drawing for a \$25 Amazon gift certificate. A total of 5 gift certificates will be awarded. You must be a KCU student for Fall 2024 which includes graduate and online students, a KCU faculty/adjunct member, a KCU alum or a KCU staff member to participate.

You can find books to read at your local library, on free eBook sites or eBooks in our KCU library catalog. Any titles that are posted will also be pinned to our library [Pinterest page](#) for you to browse in case you want to read what someone else has read.

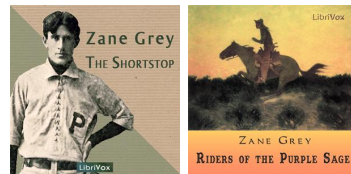

Library Technology Helpful Hints

Summer is a great time to practice using new phones, new computers, and new apps to help you stay organized once you return to campus! This summer, we recommend that you try using Google Keep. This app allows you to create 'post it' notes to help you stay organized. You can keep a to-do list, a packing list for college, and a schedule for the week. You can color code your notes and pin important notes to the top of your list. You can even share your notes with friends and family!
