BANNED BOOKS WEEK Sept. 22-28, 2024

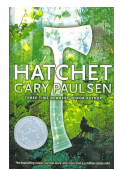
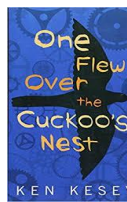
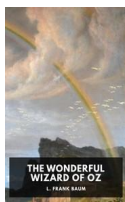
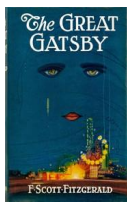

Google Tasks allows users to make customizable to-do lists accessible through other Google products (Gmail, Drive, Calendar, etc.) in a web browser or as a phone app. To get started, simply click "Add a task," and you're on your way!!
